Eligibility:

(D1) Born June 1, 2002 - May 31, 2004

(D2) Born June 1, 2000 - May 31, 2002

(D3) Born June 1, 1998* - May 31, 2000

(D4) *6th - 8th Grade

***6th grade eligibility:** 6th graders that are eligible to wrestle in D3 can wrestle in either D3 or D4. You can only wrestle in one division throughout the post-season. No 7th grader can wrestle in D3 division.

Section Eligibility: Must live in one of these counties-Norte, Siskiyou, Modoc, Humbolt, Trinity, Shasta, Lassen, Tehama, Plumas, Glenn, Butte, Lake, Colusa, Sutter, Yuba, Sierra, Nevada, Yolo, Placer, El Dorado, Sacramento, Amador, San Joaquin, Calaveras, Alpine, Stanislaus, Tuolumne or Mono.
